Moving Forward

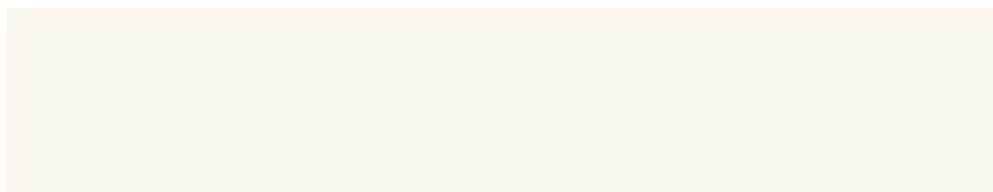
