

One of the reasons given for modern youth's use of drugs and alcohol, their rates of crime, accidents, suicide, and other problems, is that young people perceive life as mindless and meaningless. According to the theologian Paul Tillich, the word "God" translates as the depth of our life, the source of our being, and our ultimate concern: what we take seriously without any reservation. So, our search for meaning connects with our search for God. Little of young people's exposure - in the media, or among their peers – prepares them to seek life's meaning. They see nothing worth dying for. And if you have nothing to die for, you have nothing to live for. As a result, when young people think of the future, they think of how they're going to make a living instead of how they're going to live their life. lesus took steps to provide the world with what the letter to the Ephesians and the Book of Amos were talking about: meaning to life, hope to a fragmented world. As Amos had been sent to preach social justice and Paul to preach repentance to pagans as well as Jews, both in the face of rejection, so Jesus sent the twelve apostles.
