Gospel: John 2:1-11

On a very deep level, we can apply today's lessons to the wedding party that is our life, because Jesus cared about people and wanted them to enjoy themselves and be happy. He wasn't a killjoy: He made people feel good about themselves, as though they were bathed in sunshine. The people who crucified Jesus never accused him of being a bore. To the contrary, they thought him too dynamic to be safe. It has been later generations that muffled up Jesus' personality and surround him with an atmosphere of tedium and recommended him as a fitting household pet for the insecure, vulnerable and retiring.

Jesus is the Jesus of the wedding feast, but the party entails work that is very serious. We should work for justice, justice in our own lives, in our own communities and in the world, because without justice there can be no party! We should feed the hungry, because without feeding the hungry there can be no party! We should respond to God's invitations as the ongoing way of the life of love of a bridegroom and his bride, or there can be no party!
