#### **Dear Parishioners**

Pro-active love is fundamental to Christian living. It's not okay to live by the Golden Rule on a Sunday and for the rest of the week live by "an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth!"

In the Gospel Jesus lists common ways that people think is sensible conduct toward our neighbour — loving those who love you, doing good to those who do good to you, lending money to those from whom you expect to be repaid. But Jesus says that is not enough: In each case he concludes by asking, "what credit is that to you?" The poet Jane Merchant wrote:

If I forgive an injury

Because resenting would poison me –

I may feel noble, I may feel splendid,

But it isn't exactly what Christ intended.

Jesus' standard of comparison is God. Only if we love our enemies and expect nothing back will we be acting like God. Difficult? You bet it is. That's why Chesterton said, "Christianity has not been tried and found wanting; it has been found difficult and not tried.
